

Family Prize Quiz Trail 2026



Enjoy a walk around the City of just over a mile, answer the quiz questions, return the completed form to the Tourist Information Centre (TIC) at the Guildhall. There are 20 questions to answer!

All correct answer forms will go into a draw for a voucher for 4 people to play at High Score Arcades!

Exit the TIC to start the quiz!

When outside the Guildhall turn right towards Hotel Chocolat, by the post box turn to the right down Copenhagen Street. STOP on the corner opposite Joules.

1. What was Copenhagen Street formally known as?

Continue down Copenhagen Street and STOP outside The Kiln.

2. Between which years was this building The Police headquarters?

Carry on walking down Copenhagen Street to the traffic lights. Use the traffic lights to cross the road. STOP at the sign board for St. Andrew's Gardens.

3. What are the What3words for this location?

Continue into the gardens. Take the 2nd path on the right towards the board about St. Andrew's Church.

4. What destroyed the Medieval spire in 1733?

Keep walking around The Glover's Needle (St. Andrew's Spire) and down the steps. Continue walking along the paths and down all the staircases towards the river.

When you reach the bottom of the final set of stairs on South Quay (near fountains), STOP and look to your right.

5. What animal guards the doors of Browns Restaurant?

Continue toward the river and turn left at the fountains, walk along the river path to the black Welcome to Worcester sign board on your left.

6. What attraction is at number 7 on the map?
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Carry on walking down the path away from South Quay. After the benches STOP and look at the wall on the left.

7. What was the Doctor's name who founded the Royal Porcelain Works factory that stood near this site?
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Continue walking along the river path towards the Cathedral. When you get to the black directional signpost on the right-hand side of the path. Turn left and STOP to look at the wall on the right.

8. What is the date for the lowest flood marker on this wall?
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Walk through the iron gates and to the left up the stairs. At the top of the stairs turn right and walk up the hill. When you reach the top of the hill walk on the grass in front of you.

9. How many trees are planted on the Green you are standing on?
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Walk back onto the tarmac (careful of cars!) and continue around the Green with the Cathedral on your left. STOP before you head under Edgar Tower.

10. What number is The Guesten?
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Now walk under Edgar Tower, using the pedestrian door on the right-hand side.

Before the end of the path STOP and look to your left.

11. What is the name of the Saint these steps are dedicated after?

Walk up the steps and walking along the path keeping the Cathedral on your left. Look to your right and find the house with the blue plaque on it dedicated to Sir Edward Elgar.

12. Elgar lived at the house with the blue plaque, which number house is it?

Continue walking towards the road before you turn left at the end of the path STOP.

13. What fruit is on top of the directional signpost?

Now turn left and walk along the path to the traffic lights. Cross over at the traffic lights.

When you have crossed turn to the right and walk past the bus stop, cross over the entrance to the NCP car park (being careful of cars!) towards OTTO. Walk past OTTO and down the hill.

At the bottom of the hill turn left where Ye Olde Talbot is on the corner down and walk down Friar Street.

Look at the buildings on the right, when you see an old black and white building (between Topsy Teacup and Globe) STOP.

14. What dates are on the plaque at the centre of this building?

Continue walking down Friar Street and STOP opposite Tick Tock watch and clock repairs.

15. Who is the blue plaque dedicated to on this building?

Carry on walking down Friar Street into the pedestrian zone. After spotting the barbers Blow your Top on your left, look for the iron gate on your right.

16. What name is given to the Almshouses that stand behind these gates?

Continue a little further on until you reach Greyfriars on your right.

17. Who owns/looks after Greyfriars?

Continue walking to the corner of the road. STOP on the corner.

18. What bird is the pub on the corner named after?

Turn left towards the British Heart Foundation Charity Shop and walk up the hill. As you walk up the hill look at the shops on your right.

19. Which of the shops has the year 1881 engraved into the front of the building?

At the top of the hill turn right and continue walking until you reach the Guildhall on your left. STOP outside the Guildhall.

20. What are the names of the 2 statues that stand either side of the Guildhall doors?
